## NOMINATION: SILK ROAD: INNOVATIONS



Uzbekistan's stunning ceramics are surely among the world's oldest and finest. Prized for their vibrant patterns since the days when merchants plied the legendary Silk Road, these pieces are just as delightful today, adding a sophisticated splash of colour to any sideboard or dining table. Because Uzbek potters only use natural, mostly local materials, each piece has a distinct, regional panache. The clay itself impacts on the colour and texture of the finished item and the plants or minerals used for paints and glazes - lapis lazuli for blues, or the wild Ishkor plant for the famous ash glazes - are all milled by hand. Many of the features that make Uzbek ceramics so dynamic developed, such as the intricate designs combining nature motifs with triangles or complex strap work patterns. Stylised birds and animals were popular motifs, often inspired by local legends, and because the lead glazes did not interfere with the colour scheme, local artisans could create fantastic designs. The Middle Ages saw the dawn of a cultural Golden Age. The bustling Silk Road attracted artisans from far and wide. New colours and designs appeared: peonies, phoenixes, deer, storks, and dragons from China and lavish arabesques and plant patterns from the Far East, finished with dazzling blue and turquoise paints.

On January 6, 2023, a Skill Development Lab was established within the premises of the school under the aegis of ONGC. Under the Annual Component Plan of All India SC ST Employees Welfare Association, established by Oil and Natural Gas Corporation. The main objective of this lab is to include courses for SC/ST students who due to various reasons, are unable to complete their education or are unable to obtain higher education after completing their studies, so that they can become capable of securing employment after completing the training. The courses of this training program include Printed Circuit Board, Electronics for Beginners, Making of Educational Toys, Health Care, and Digital Marketing.

Onwards January 18, 2023, the Skill Development Lab established under the ONCG, where students of classes 9th and 11th are being trained in three groups to make toys from pine wood, printed circuit boards, sound healing, medical lab technician, and digital marketing.



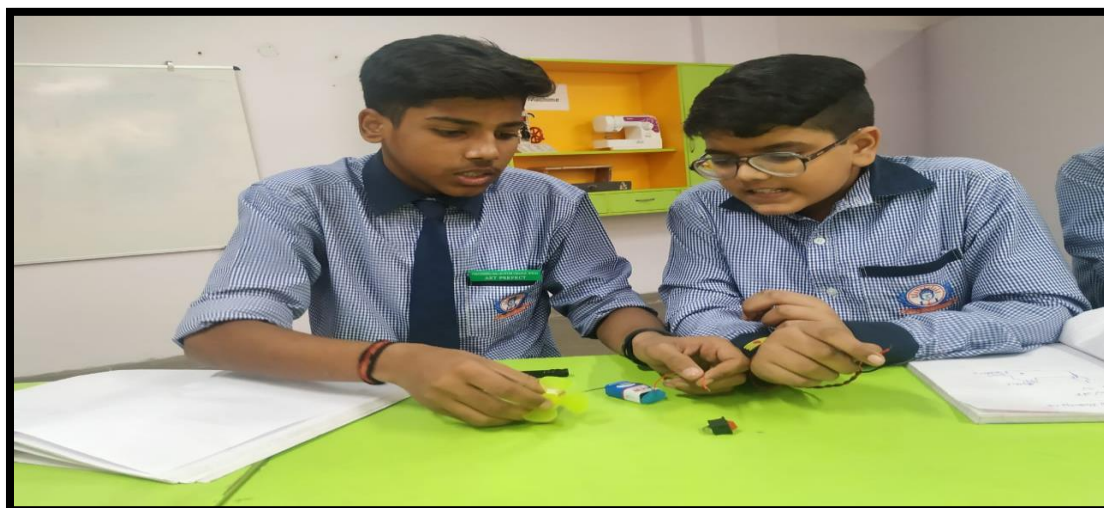
### **ATL LAB ACTIVITIES**

From September 12 to 14, 2022, a three-day state-level ATL teacher training program was organized, titled "**ATL Unboxed Tinkering Teachers Training Program**". Twenty teachers from various districts of Uttar Pradesh participated in this training program and received information on modern technology and technical details related to the latest 21st-century skills such as critical thinking, designing thinking, etc. The training was conducted by representatives from the National Policy Commission and the SRS Foundation.

On September 15, 2022, ATL teacher trainees visited an Atal Incubation Centre established at Meerut KMIT College in which they saw, visited and understood various advanced and modern technical machines. This visit was extremely educational for ATL's teacher trainees.



On the Occasion of Children's day 14<sup>th</sup> Nov.2022, in the Atal Tinkering Lab, students created their projects during a live session. As part of the Atal Innovation Mission by the Niti Aayog, Atal Tinkering Day was celebrated on November 14th, during which the school's students also received online guidance online and created their projects within the specified time, and obtained information about projects made by other schools.



On April 9, 2022, an inter-school Hands-on Science competition was organized with the main objective of providing an opportunity to see and learn by oneself, where they could understand various aspects of science deeply. This inter-school Hands-on Science competition was jointly organized by Panchsheel Science Education Center, SmartiVity Labs Pvt. Limited, and the American University of Global Peace. Accepting the challenge of the competition, all the students enthusiastically prepared their projects. After the scrutiny, examination, and evaluation



by the jury committee, the results were announced. All the winning students were awarded prizes and certificates to encourage them.



On April 20, 2022, a competition was organized by Creative Thinkers Foundation in the school under the title **"Risk assessment of open minded problems: A capacity building approach for school students and teachers"**. The competition was aimed at students and teachers from classes 6 to 9, with the goal of identifying and facing risks based on their scientific perspective and logical abilities. As part of this, students were required to complete some challenging tasks with the help of their team members. The students succeeded in the competition and were selected to participate in the inter-school competition where they were awarded a bronze medal.

On 1st June 2022, under the Science Education Center of Panchsheel Balak Inter College, an inter-school hands-on science activity was organized in which students from classes 5, 6, and 7 of various schools participated. Through this activity, students were made aware of the conductors and insulators of electricity so that they could increase their knowledge of science in their daily lives through this experiment. Smartivity Labs Pvt. Ltd provided kits to the students during this activity. Merit certificates were given to winners and participation certificates were given to participants.

On November 7, 2022, two teams of 2 students from classes 6 & 9 of Panchsheel School participated and got consolation prize in the district-level science exhibition organized by the National Children's Science Congress, which was held at Bihari Lal Inter College, Dankaur..

The 30th Children's Science Congress had the main theme of understanding democracy for health and well-being, under which five sub-themes were identified. The sub-themes were to promote health, nutrition, and well-being and to adopt a democratic perspective for self-reliance.



## LITERARY CLUB

On April 1, 2022, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi organized a discussion on exams “Pareeksha pe Charcha” for students across the country, where he provided solutions related to student life and exams in his video speech and in the students' video speeches. ## **SCHOLARSHIP**

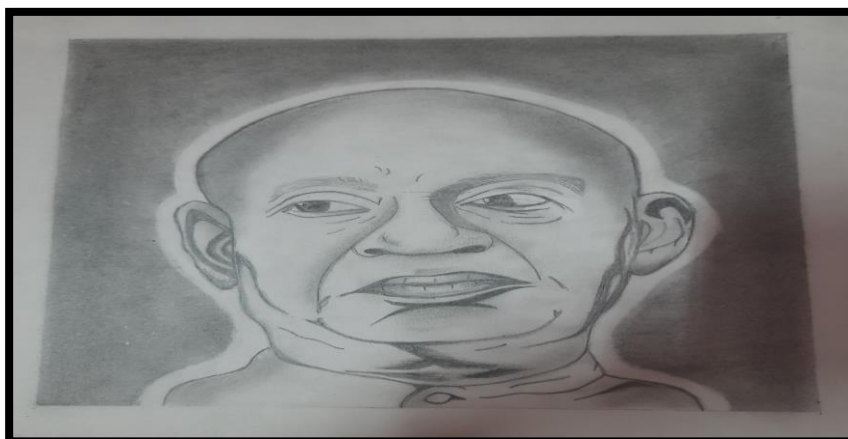

## NOMINATION: SILK ROAD: INNOVATIONS



Uzbekistan's stunning ceramics are surely among the world's oldest and finest. Prized for their vibrant patterns since the days when merchants plied the legendary Silk Road, these pieces are just as delightful today, adding a sophisticated splash of colour to any sideboard or dining table. Because Uzbek potters only use natural, mostly local materials, each piece has a distinct, regional panache. The clay itself impacts on the colour and texture of the finished item and the plants or minerals used for paints and glazes - lapis lazuli for blues, or the wild lshkor plant for the famous ash glazes - are all milled by hand. Many of the features that make Uzbek ceramics so dynamic developed, such as the intricate designs combining nature motifs with triangles or complex strap work patterns. Stylised birds and animals were popular motifs, often inspired by local legends, and because the lead glazes did not interfere with the colour scheme, local artisans could create fantastic designs. The Middle Ages saw the dawn of a cultural Golden Age. The bustling Silk Road attracted artisans from far and wide. New colours and designs appeared: peonies, phoenixes, deer, storks, and dragons from China and lavish arabesques and plant patterns from the Far East, finished with dazzling blue and turquoise paints.


